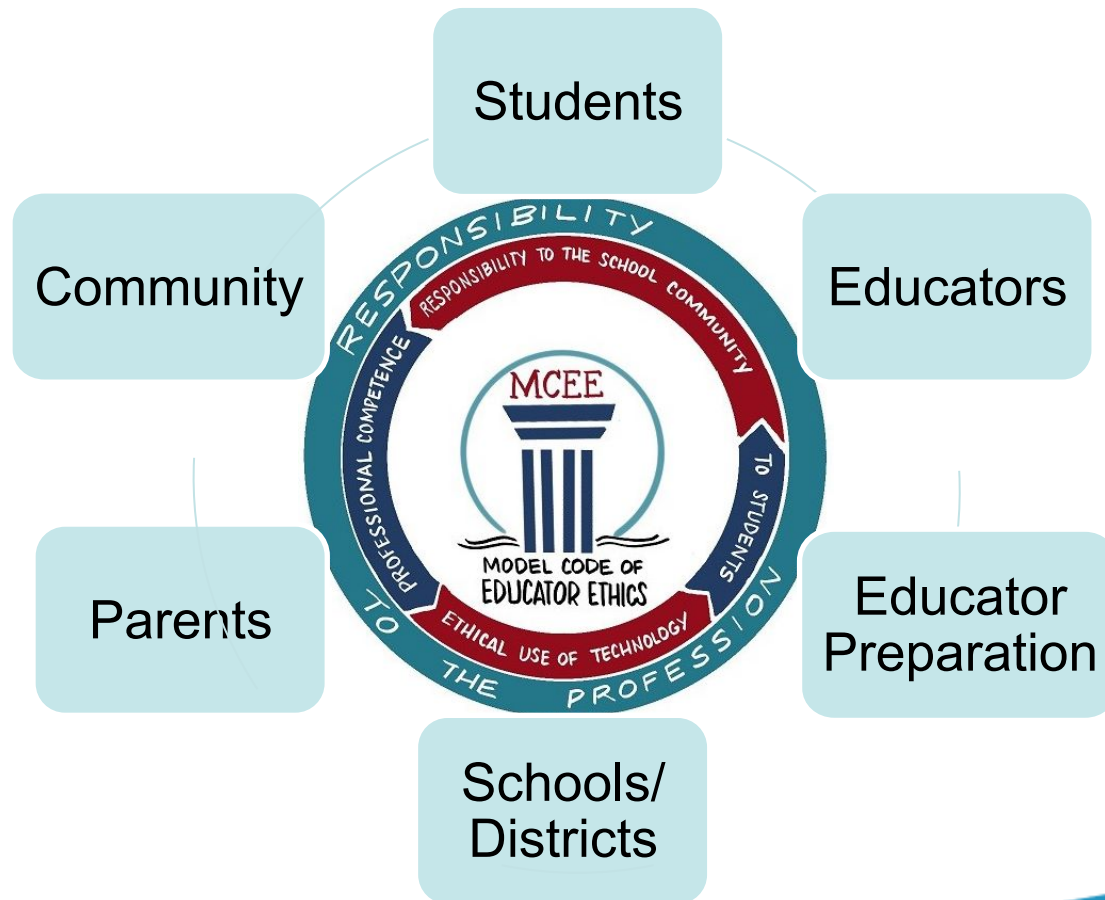

1. Responsibility to the Profession
2. Responsibility for Professional Competence
3. Responsibility to Students
4. Responsibility to the School Community
5. Responsible and Ethical use of Technology

## **National Council of the Advancement of Educator Ethics (NCAEE)**

- Championing the MCEE
- Raising awareness of the professional responsibility for ethical practice
- Equipping educators in ethical understanding
- Supporting educators' ethical decision making



# NASDTEC Clearinghouse

- 1960s NASDTEC established the Revocation Committee
- 1987 Clearinghouse on mainframe and floppy disks
- 1996 Clearinghouse moved to internet
- Clearinghouse resides on a dedicated secure server
- FTP downloads are encrypted
- Oldest Records: 1970
- Currently there are 79,560 records in the system
- 5,220 records were entered into the system in 2015
  - 381 Denials (7%)
  - 1,511 Suspensions (29%)
  - 1,292 Revocations (25%)
  - 607 Surrender of License (12%)
  - 715 Reinstatements (14%)
  - 656 Public Reprimands (13%)
  - 58 Not Available (1%)
